Since the publication of its first Ethics Opinion in 1979, the Board of Overseers has issued more than 200 opinions on a wide range of issues pertinent to the practice of law. In this session, Bar Counsel will delve into select Ethics Opinions as well as Enduring Ethics Opinions issued by the Professional Ethics Commission of particular relevance in the past several years.
