That the Court defers on its ruling on the fairness, reasonableness, approval and authorization to pay from available funds held or controlled by the Receiver relative to the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver during the period of July 1, 2019 through and including October 31, 2019 (the "Invoice Period") until it has had an opportunity to review the Receiver's invoice in full;

3. That the Twelfth Interim Report and Eleventh Interim Request for Fees of the Receiver will be scheduled for hearing on January 28, 2020, at 9:30am;


4. That the Receiver's Bond previously posted in this matter shall remain in place until ordered cancelled by this Court;
