THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S FOURTH STATUS REPORT, FOR DECEMBER 26, 2017

On November 29, 2017, the Superior Court, Stern, J., issued an Order requiring that the Rhode Island Department of Attorney General (hereinafter "Attorney General") provide weekly status updates to Special Counsel and the Court on the status of the Attorney General's efforts to comply with the subpoena served on the Attorney General on November 3, 2017 (the "Subpoena"). On December 19, 2017, the Attorney General filed the Third Status Report. The within report will update the Court through December 26, 2017.

The Attorney General has taken the following action in compliance with the Subpoena as of December 26, 2017:

- 1. On December 20, 2017, Special Counsel sent a letter identifying a number of confidential exhibits from the 2014 HCA review that he prioritized. On December 21, 2017, the Attorney General delivered those exhibits to Special Counsel. Thereafter, on December 21, 2017, Special Counsel emailed the Attorney General identifying an additional confidential exhibit that is a priority. The Attorney General emailed the exhibit to Special Counsel later that afternoon.
- 2. At the status conference on December 21, 2017, Special Counsel requested the confidential exhibit list from the 2009 HCA review. Later that afternoon, the

Attorney General provided that list to Special Counsel. On December 22, 2017,

Special Counsel sent a letter to the Attorney General requesting that the Attorney

General prioritize production of all the confidential exhibits from the 2009 HCA

review, but that he was unable to identify any specific documents that should

receive special priority. After all of the 2014 HCA review hard-copy documents

have been produced, the Attorney General will move forward with review and

production of the 2009 HCA review hard-copy documents.

3. On December 21, 2017, pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Proposed Case Management

Plan, the Attorney General provided Special Counsel with an update on the scope

of Electronically Stored Information ("ESI"). Specifically, the Attorney General

identified custodians, search terms, and an update as to data retrieved to date.

Special Counsel replied with a letter to the Attorney General on December 22, 2017

requesting additional search terms and specific formats for production. The

Attorney General has reviewed the letter, is addressing the ESI now that the

custodians and the search terms have been identified, and will respond.

4. On Friday, December 22, 2017, WarRoom delivered three (3) boxes of documents

containing documents related to the 2014 HCA review and two (2) boxes related to

the 2009 HCA review. Rolling production of boxes from WarRoom will continue

this week with an additional five (5) boxes estimated for delivery by the end of the

week. Once that delivery is received, the Attorney General will have twenty-five

(25) of the twenty-nine (29) boxes returned from WarRoom.

5. On December 22, 2017, the Attorney General delivered to Special Counsel the

following four (4) boxes of documents with logs identifying privileged and

confidential documents as necessary:
