## THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S FIFTH STATUS REPORT FOR JANAURY 2, 2018

On November 29, 2017, the Superior Court, Stern, J., issued an Order requiring that the Rhode Island Department of Attorney General (hereinafter "Attorney General") provide weekly status updates to Special Counsel and the Court on the status of the Attorney General's efforts to comply with the subpoena served on the Attorney General on November 3, 2017 (the "Subpoena"). On December 26, 2017, the Attorney General filed the Fourth Status Report. The within report will update the Court through January 2, 2018.

The Attorney General has taken the following action in compliance with the Subpoena as of January 2, 2018:

- 1. On Wednesday, December 27, 2017, Special Counsel contacted the Attorney General to request a letter describing the process involved in our hard document review and production in compliance with the Subpeona. As discussed, on January 2, 2018, we responded in writing to the request.
- 2. On Friday, December 29, 2017, WarRoom delivered five (5) boxes of documents all containing documents related to the 2009 HCA review. Rolling production of boxes from WarRoom will continue this week with the final four (4) boxes estimated for delivery by the end of the week. Once that delivery is received, the

Attorney General will have all of the twenty-nine (29) boxes returned from WarRoom.

- 3. On December 28, 2017, the Attorney General delivered to Special Counsel the following two (2) boxes of documents with logs identifying privileged and confidential documents as necessary:
  - 1. Box 16 Bates Stamped: AG14-16-000001-003351 (contains a total of 2,928 confidential documents from the 2014 HCA review); and
  - 2. Box 17 Bates Stamped: AG14-17-000001-002753 (contains a total of 2,431 confidential documents from the 2014 HCA review).
- 4. On January 2, 2018, the Attorney General delivered to Special Counsel the following two (2) boxes of documents with logs identifying privileged and confidential documents as necessary:
