STATUS UPDATE CONCERNING THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF PROVIDENCE, A CORPORATION SOLE'S RESPONSE TO SUBPOENA

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Providence, a corporation sole ("RCB"), files this status report regarding its response to the November 2, 2017 subpoena ("Subpoena") served by special counsel to the court-appointed receiver ("Special Counsel") in the above-referenced proceedings.

- 1. On January 5, 2018, Special Counsel provided RCB with authorization under Rule 7(e) of the Supreme Court Rules Governing Electronic Filing to file the stipulation and protective order ("Protective Order") that the parties had negotiated. RCB subsequently filed the Protective Order, which the Court entered.
- 2. That same day, RCB produced 431 documents and 2,230 pages pursuant to the Protective Order. The production consisted of confidential documents—predominantly Election of Benefits forms—containing personal identifying information of hospital employees and pension beneficiaries.
- 3. RCB also harvested a small collection of additional documents in response to meet and confer discussions with Special Counsel. RCB has completed its review of those documents for responsiveness and privilege and is having these documents processed for production. We anticipate
