### THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEVENTH STATUS REPORT

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On November 29, 2017, the Superior Court, Stern, J., issued an Order requiring that the Rhode Island Department of Attorney General (hereinafter "Attorney General") provide weekly status updates to Special Counsel and the Court on the status of the Attorney General's efforts to comply with the subpoena served on the Attorney General on November 3, 2017 (the "Subpoena"). On January 16, 2018, the Attorney General filed the Seventh Status Report. The within report will supplement the Seventh Status Report and update the Court through January 19, 2018.

The Attorney General has taken the following action in compliance with the Subpoena as of January 19, 2018:

1. On Tuesday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, the Attorney General filed a Motion and Memorandum in Support to Extend Time to Respond to Requests 1 and 3 of the Subpoena for an additional Ten (10) Days (the "Motion"). The Attorney General's Motion is scheduled to be heard on Monday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 9:30 AM. As of filing of this Report, the Attorney General's hard document and ESI production is complete. Therefore, the only outstanding item of the Attorney General's production is the privilege log for the Electronically Stored Information ("ESI") which includes emails and/or documents resulting from the identified custodians and search terms proposed by Special Counsel. 2. On January 19<sup>th</sup>, the Attorney General produced an additional 170 pages of ESI emails and/or documents based on the identified custodians and search terms proposed by Special Counsel.<sup>1</sup> Additionally, approximately 880 items of ESI emails and/or documents (355 native word documents, 4 excel spreadsheets, and 521 PDF files) have been withheld pursuant to the work-product, attorney-client, quasi-judicial immunity and deliberative process privileges. In an effort to continue expediting production of responsive ESI, the Attorney General has produced ESI resulting from the search terms while continuing to complete appropriate privilege logs, to be produced on or before January 26, 2018.

3. On January 19<sup>th</sup>, the Attorney General produced in electronic format, with confidential labeling as required, the remaining ESI for the 2014 HCA review, amounting to a total of 6,181 pages, as maintained in the ordinary course of business (AGE14-000001 to AGE14-004335 and AGE14-007114.1 to AGE14-010962 – produced with a privilege log detailing a total of 2,002 pages withheld pursuant to the work-product, attorney-client, quasi-judicial immunity and deliberative process privileges).

4. Attached are <u>Exhibits A</u>, <u>B</u> and <u>C</u>, which are three (3) charts reflecting the Attorney General's total production in compliance with the Subpoena. The charts also display the number of privileged documents withheld.

a. <u>Exhibit A</u>: This exhibit reflects the hard document production completed for the 2009 and 2014 HCA reviews and the subsequent monitoring for the 2014 HCA review, including 63,855 pages, 30,442 of which were labeled confidential and 3,823 of which were withheld for privileged.

- b. <u>Exhibit B</u>: This exhibit reflects the ESI production completed for the 2009 and 2014 HCA reviews and the subsequent monitoring for the 2014 HCA review, as well as the ESI related to the identified custodians and search terms, including 150,797 pages, 6,869 of which were withheld for privileged for the 2009 and 2014 HCA reviews.<sup>2</sup>
- c. <u>Exhibit C</u>: This exhibit reflects the total productions (hard copy and ESI), including 214,822 pages, 30,442 of which were labeled confidential in the hard document production, and 10,692 of which were withheld for privileged for the 2009 and 2014 HCA reviews, and subsequent monitoring for the 2014 HCA review hard copy and ESI production.

5. Having provided a comprehensive response to the Subpoena in general in the Seventh Status Report, the Attorney General provides an amended response to the Request No. 4 outlined below:

**<u>RESPONSE 4</u>**: With regard to hard document production, the Attorney General has produced Boxes 26-29 as detailed in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached. With regard to ESI, the Attorney has produced AGE14-004336 to AGE14-007114 (produced with a privilege log detailing a total of 1,282 pages withheld pursuant to the work-product, attorney-client, quasi-judicial immunity and deliberative process privileges). Additionally, the Attorney General amends this response to note that responsive documents are provided in the 2014 HCA hard document and ESI files to the extent they contain correspondence and/or other documents dated after the HCA decision was issued on May 16, 2014.
