3. I submit this declaration upon personal knowledge to demonstrate CCCB'S compliance with the notice requirements of the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005, 28 U.S.C. §1715 ("CAFA").
4. On November 21, 2018, Plaintiffs and Defendants CCCB, St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island ("SJHSRI"), and Roger Williams Hospital ("RWH") (collectively the "Settling Parties") filed their Joint Motion for Preliminary Approval of Partial Settlement.

5. On June 6, 2019, this Court signed a Memorandum and Order preliminarily approving the proposed class action settlement between the Settling Parties in the above-captioned action.
6. 



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
