Del Sesto this morning. We did have a hearing this morning and we had some audio issues so I rescheduled it right after this one. I told Attorney Robinson that we would not let Attorney Fragomeni hold up the hearing so we can get to his. I have read the papers. The Receiver may proceed.

MR. DEL SESTO: Thank you, your Honor. And knowing that the Court has read the papers I will keep it brief. Your Honor, notice of this hearing was provided to all interested parties and creditors and there is an affidavit of notice on file reflecting the same. This is the sixteenth interim report and fifteenth request for fees.

I was last before your Honor on October 20, 2020. With the exception of those matters that were set forth in the report, your Honor, the only change I think of any significance is that as your Honor knows there are hearings scheduled for tomorrow, December 10th. Those hearings have been continued to January. So actually it's been continued, but I don't know for certain if we set a date yet on the continuation of those hearing dates.

And one note is that the stipulation that was entered into between Prospect and myself and the other Defendants in the federal action regarding the exercise

of the put, which has always been an issue before this Court, that has been continued by agreement and stipulation to January 15th.

Beyond that, your Honor, as I report to the Court benefit payments are running just about a million dollars a month and there are other fees and expenses of the plan, monthly fees and expenses of the plan, which increase that to about \$1.1 million, \$1.15 million per month, so that is our burn rate in terms of benefit payments. Because of the strength of the market, we are getting some pretty good returns, but still those returns are not outpacing the distribution of benefits.

As of today, your Honor, or as of the filing of the report, we have in total about \$67 million in the plan, which is just about \$20 million less than what we had in 2017 when we started. And we continue to do what we can to bolster the plan through investments. The participants have been good in terms of not making what I will call a run on the plan in terms of benefits, but they are -- we still have monthly applications.

And just so your Honor is aware, I still continue via Zoom the town hall meetings and there is one scheduled, I believe, for next Tuesday. Your Honor, I try to do one right before the holidays and right after a few of the hearings so I can get them up to date.

Unless your Honor has any questions, again, knowing that your Honor has read the report, I don't have anything more to add other than what was in the report and what I just stated.

Thank you, counsel. I have read your THE COURT: report and request for fees and disbursements. objections having been filed, the Court accepts the interim report ratifying the acts and doings of the Receiver in this case. In addition, the Court has reviewed the fees, costs, and expenses for this report as submitted. The Court finds those are fair, reasonable, and for the benefit of the estate in this case and those fees, costs, and expenses are approved. I would ask counsel to submit the appropriate order. I believe I saw an e-mail that an order has been submitted and the Court will get that signed and put in the file and you can pick a date shortly for the next interim report.

MR. DEL SESTO: I will contact Clerk Miley, your Honor, to schedule the 17th report, and I will submit the proposed order for today through the portal as well as e-mail a copy to yourself and Clerk Miley.
