It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17.14 of the General Laws entitled "The Hospital Conversions
 Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **23-17.14-35.** Court-approved settlements.
- 4 The following provisions apply solely and exclusively to judicially approved good faith
- 5 settlements of claims relating to the St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island Retirement Plan,

6 <u>also sometimes known as the St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island pension plan:</u>

- 7 (1) A release by a claimant of one joint tortfeasor, whether before or after judgment, does
- 8 not discharge the other joint tortfeasors unless the release so provides, but such release shall
- 9 reduce the claim against the other joint tortfeasors in the amount of the consideration paid for the
- 10 <u>release.</u>
- 11 (2) A release by a claimant of one joint tortfeasor relieves them from liability to make
- 12 <u>contribution to another joint tortfeasor.</u>
- 13 (3) For purposes of this section, a good faith settlement is one that does not exhibit
- 14 collusion, fraud, dishonesty, or other wrongful or tortious conduct intended to prejudice the non-
- 15 settling tortfeasor(s), irrespective of the settling or non-settling tortfeasors' proportionate share of
- 16 <u>liability.</u>

- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall apply to all claims pending
- 2 at the time of passage or asserted thereafter; provided, however, that this act shall not apply to,
- 3 affect or impair releases executed before the date of passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY - THE HOSPITAL CONVERSIONS ACT

1 This act would provide that in connection with judicially approved good faith settlements 2 of claims relating to the St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island Retirement Plan, a release by 3 a claimant of one joint tortfeasor shall not discharge other joint tortfeasors unless the release so 4 provides, but shall reduce the claim against the other joint tortfeasors in the amount of the 5 consideration paid. 6 This act would take effect upon passage and would apply to claims pending at the time of

passage or asserted thereafter; provided, however, that this act would not apply to, affect or impair releases executed before the date of passage.

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
