ORDER GRANTING LIQUIDATING RECEIVER'S PETITION
TO ENGAGE ACCOUNTANTS

This matter came before this Court on March 30, 2020, Justice Stern presiding, on the petition by Thomas S. Hemmendinger (the "Liquidating Receiver"), permanent liquidating receiver of CharterCARE Community Board, St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island, and Roger Williams Hospital (the "Petitioners"), to engage Kahn, Litwin, Renza & Co., Ltd. ("KLR") as accountants. After hearing all parties present and interested, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Liquidating Receiver gave due and adequate notice of the petition and of the date and time of this Court's consideration of the petition counsel of record in this liquidating receivership, to Stephen Del Sesto, Esq., as receiver for the St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island Retirement Plan, and his counsel, and to counsel of record for Prospect Chartercare, LLC and its affiliates. Under the circumstances, no further notice to parties in interest is required.

2. The petition is granted. The Liquidating Receiver is authorized to do the following: (a) engage and pay KLR as accountants on the terms proposed in the petition; and (b) pay any pre-receivership balance owed to KLR on the matters for which they were engaged pre-receivership.

3. The Court ratifies and approves the Liquidating Receiver's actions in connection with the matters set forth in the petition.
