ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 1. That the Fifth Interim Report of Stephen F. Del Sesto, Esq., in his capacity as Temporary and Permanent Receiver herein, and all acts, doings, and disbursements of said Receiver and Special Counsel to date are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified;
- 2. That the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver during the period of May 1, 2018 through and including June 30, 2018 (the "PA Invoice Period"), and the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver's Special Counsel during the period of May 1, 2018, through and including June 17, 2018 (the "WSL Invoice Period"), are fair and reasonable;

- 3. That the Receiver's Fourth Interim request for fees incurred during the PA Invoice Period in the amount of \$\frac{62,000.60}{29.61}\$ and costs and expenses in the amount of \$29.61 are all hereby approved in full. The Receiver is authorized and directed to pay himself in full from available cash-on-hand in the Estate;
- 5. That the next interim report of the Receiver will be filed and scheduled for hearing within approximately sixty (60) days from entry of this Order;
- 6. That the Receiver's recommendation to further postpone any modification to monthly benefit payments until, at least, the hearing on the Receiver's Sixth Interim Report is GRANTED;
- 7. That the Receiver's Bond previously posted in this matter shall remain in place until ordered cancelled by this Court; and
- 8. That this matter shall remain open and the Order Appointing Permanent Receiver entered herein shall remain in full force and effect until further Order of this Court.
