**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATION AND
PROPOSED ORDER EXTENDING BRIEFING DEADLINES**

Defendants Roman Catholic Bishop of Providence, a corporation sole, Diocesan Administration Corporation, and Diocesan Service Corporation (collectively, the “Diocesan Defendants”) and Plaintiff Stephen Del Sesto (the “Receiver”) and the individual named plaintiffs (individually and as putative class representatives) (with the Receiver, “Plaintiffs”) move for entry of the stipulation and proposed order extending the remaining deadlines in the Court’s May 2, 2022 order, ECF No. 249, attached at Exhibit A. In support thereof, the Parties state:

1. Plaintiffs filed their oppositions to the Diocesan Defendants’ motion for summary judgment and renewed motion to dismiss on April 18, 2022. Plaintiffs also filed a conditional motion for discovery under Rule 56(d) on the same day.
2. Given the scope of Plaintiffs’ briefing, the Diocesan Defendants have determined that they will need an additional extension until June 30, 2022 to complete their responses to Plaintiffs’ oppositions and conditional motion. The Diocesan Defendants have represented to plaintiffs that they will not seek any further

extensions with respect to these responses. Plaintiffs have agreed to the extension.

3. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

Wherefore, the Parties respectfully request the entry of the attached stipulation and proposed order extending the remaining deadlines in the Court's May 2, 2022 order as follows: The Diocesan Defendants shall file their replies in further support of their motion for summary judgment and renewed motion to dismiss, as well as their response to Plaintiffs' Rule 56(d) conditional motion, on or before June 30, 2022.
