2. That the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver during the period of December 1, 2021 through and including January 31, 2022 (the "Invoice Period") are fair and reasonable;

3. That the Receiver's Twenty-First Interim request for fees, costs and expenses incurred during the Invoice Period in the amount of \$68,095.00 are all hereby approved in full. The Receiver is authorized and directed to pay himself in full from available sources of cash in or held by the Estate;

4. That the Twenty-Third Interim Report and Twenty-Second Interim Request for Fees of the Receiver is scheduled for WebEx hearing on June 21, 2022 at 10:00 am;

5. That the Receiver's Bond previously posted in this matter shall remain in place until ordered cancelled by this Court; and

6. That this matter shall remain open and the Order Appointing Permanent Receiver entered herein shall remain in full force and effect until further Order of this Court.
