Preston W. Halperin hereby declares and states as follows:


1. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein, and if called to testify as a witness, I could and would testify competently to the following facts.
2. On March 19, 2021, my office, acting under my direction and supervision, served a Supplemental CAFA Notice, which consisted of a cover letter and certain accompanying documents enumerated therein, upon the United States Attorney General and the appropriate government officials for all of the states in which members of the proposed Settlement Class reside, based on information concerning residencies of members of the proposed Settlement Class provided to SHS by Attorney Stephen Del Sesto as Receiver and Administrator for the St. Joseph Health Services of Rhode Island Retirement Plan, by mailing using the United States Postal Service First Class Mail. **See Exhibit B hereto.**

7. Although not required for notice, on March 23, 2021, my office, acting under my direction and supervision, served the CAFA Notice and Supplemental Notice, upon the Rhode Island Department of Health. **See Exhibit C hereto.**

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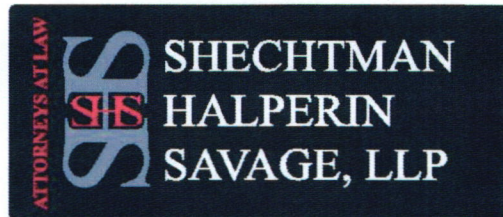
