CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 3

For purposes of the proceedings before the Special Master, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

In response to Georgia's unopposed request dated January 30, 2015, for additional time to file any Rule 12(b)(7) motion relating to the United States, the schedule established in Case Management Order No. 1 and modified by Case Management Order No. 2 is hereby further modified as set forth herein.

Section 1.3 of Case Management Order No. 1 is amended to read as follows:

Should Georgia wish to preserve any defense based on Rule 12(b)(7) for failure to join the United States as a necessary party, it shall file a motion setting forth the legal and factual grounds for such a defense within seven (7) days after service of the United States' statement of intended participation, or on February 9, 2015, whichever is later. Should Georgia wish to preserve any other defense listed in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(2)-(5) or (7), it shall file a motion setting forth the legal and factual grounds for such a defense on or before February 9, 2015. Otherwise, such defenses will be waived. Any party opposing such a motion will have ten (10) days to respond.
