1	Maine	Community drinking water systems must submit a consumer confidence report to their customers and to the appropriate agency with data collected for the previous calendar year. A new community drinking water system must deliver its first report by July 1, if 2014 was its first calendar year in operation.	
1	Maine	Deadline for certain transporters of hazardous waste to submit registration statements and annual fees to DOT.	
1	Maine	Deadline for owners of underground storage tanks to submit to DEP results of annual inspection of tank and piping by certified tank inspector or installer. This report must be on forms provided by DEP and must include the required certification.	
1	Maine	Facilities in municipalities beginning with A-L that own USTs used for storage of motor fuel, or marketing and distribution of oil, must report results of annual statistical inventory analysis for each tank to DEP.	
1	Maine	Facilities that "manufacture," "process," or "otherwise use" constituents listed pursuant to Section 313 of EPCRA in quantities exceeding threshold planning quantities must file Form Rs with appropriate agencies.	
1	Maine	Owners and operators of facilities other than commercial storers or disposers of PCB waste that use or store 99.4 lbs. of PCBs in PCB containers or transformers, or 50 or more large capacitors must prepare a document log covering the previous year.	
1	Maine	The owner or operator of an underground oil storage facility used to store motor fuels or used in the marketing and distribution of oil must report to DEP the results of an annual statistical inventory analysis for each of its tanks.	
1	Maine	The owner or operator of an underground oil storage facility used to store motor fuels or used in the marketing and distribution of oil must report to DEP the results of its annual precision test as required to meet annual leak detection requirements.	
1	New Hampshire	Expiration date for minimum impact forestry notifications issued after April 1 of the previous year or before April of the current year.	
14	Federal	Certain Group 1 petroleum storage vessel facilities subject to NSPS must submit annual report regarding emissions of VOC and SO2.	
15	Maine	Owners and operators of facilities used for the commercial storage or disposal of PCBs and PCB items must have submitted to EPA an annual report containing specified information for PCBs and PCB items handled as PCB waste in the previous year.	
15	New Hampshire	Deadline for owners and operators of NOx-emitting generation sources subject to NOx Emissions Reduction Fund to pay the quarterly fee for prior quarter.	
15	New Hampshire	Deadline for owners and operators of stationary sources, area sources, or devices having actual emissions greater than 1,000 tons to pay the quarterly emission-based fee.	
30	New Hampshire	Deadline for owners and operators of kraft mills subject to the TRS emissions rules to submit excess emissions report for prior calendar quarter.	
30	New Hampshire	Deadline for submission of quarterly reports from NOx budget sources.	
31	Maine	Deadline for submission of air emission quarterly reports to DEP and, for NSPS sources, to EPA.	
31	Maine	Facility owners and operators subject to annual EPCRA § 313 reporting requirements must submit any voluntary revisions to Form R and Form A submissions for inclusion in the annual data release for the previous calendar year.	
31	New Hampshire	Deadline for owners and operators of stationary sources, area sources, or devices to submit semi-annual permit deviation and monitoring report for January - June.

1	Federal	Deadline for sewage sludge incineration units subject to NSPS to submit semiannual deviation report.	
1	Federal	Deadline for large municipal waste combustor units subject to NSPS to submit a semiannual report containing the information specified under 40 CFR 60.59b(h).	
1	Federal	Deadline for existing commercial and industrial solid waste incineration units (CISWI) subject to NSPS (Subparts CCCC or DDDD) to submit a semiannual deviation report.	
14	Federal	Deadline for producers of a Class I controlled substance under the Montreal Protocol to submit a quarterly report to EPA.

30	New Hampshire	Deadline for facilities that undergo frequent Class S major asbestos abatement and use the annual notification form to file quarterly report of activities performed under such notification.
