- PA was doing energy efficiency work in Kazakhstan
- Expanded to drafting a "Green Economy" Law encompassing waste management, air quality, and water management

## **Green Economy Law Project**

- Vision for sustainable economy from President
- Goal: adopt/amend statutes to implement best environmental practices
  - Air transition from coal
  - Water quantity & quality
  - Waste solid waste, recycling
- Reality: extremely ambitious
  - Petroleum-based economy
  - Undeveloped governmental structures
  - o Partial environmental law statutes, virtually no rules
  - o Corruption
  - o Lack of enforcement



## **Green Economy Law Project**

- ✓ Researched international standards
- ✓ Integrated knowledge of US and EU laws
- ✓ Crash course in economy, Kaz law, culture
  - Travel to Kaz
  - Teamed with local lawyers, economist
  - Meetings with government officials and committees, business leaders, environmental NGOs, consultants
- ✓ Ultimately, proposed statutory changes and outline of rules which require adoption of BMPs in air, water and waste sectors

- Nuclear contamination
- ♦ Lack of water resources
- Significant water pollution
- ♦ Open unregulated landfills
- ♦ Coal fired power plans
